

ACADEMIC CALENDAR

Cape Henry Collegiate utilizes a semester system and is not on a block schedule. **MID-YEAR** grades are available in January. Mid-semester grades are available upon request and are not considered part of the students' official records.

ALL full-year classes for all years are reflected as one credit each.

WEIGHTING

The GPA for an academic year increases .1 for each AP class taken that year and .05 for each honors class taken.

CLASS RANK

We recognize a Valedictorian and a Salutatorian, but do not rank.

COURSE REPEAT

Courses repeated a second time provide no additional credit. The grade earned on the initial attempt of the class remains on the transcript, but only the new grade receives credit and is calculated into the GPA.

GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

All students must be enrolled in a minimum of six courses each year at	Cape Henry Collegiate.
English (To include English 12 or equivalent AP)	4 Credits

Mathematics (Minimum completion through Algebra II)	4 Credits
World Language (Three years of the same language in Upper School, or until a student completes the highest level offered of one language.)	3 Credits

Students are required to participate in a minimum of four athletic seasons across their four years at Cape Henry Collegiate. This requirement may be fulfilled through team participation, afterschool fitness training, or participation in a major school production in the performing arts.

UPPER SCHOOL CURRICULUM (GRADES 9-12)


The history department does not offer an honors track.


